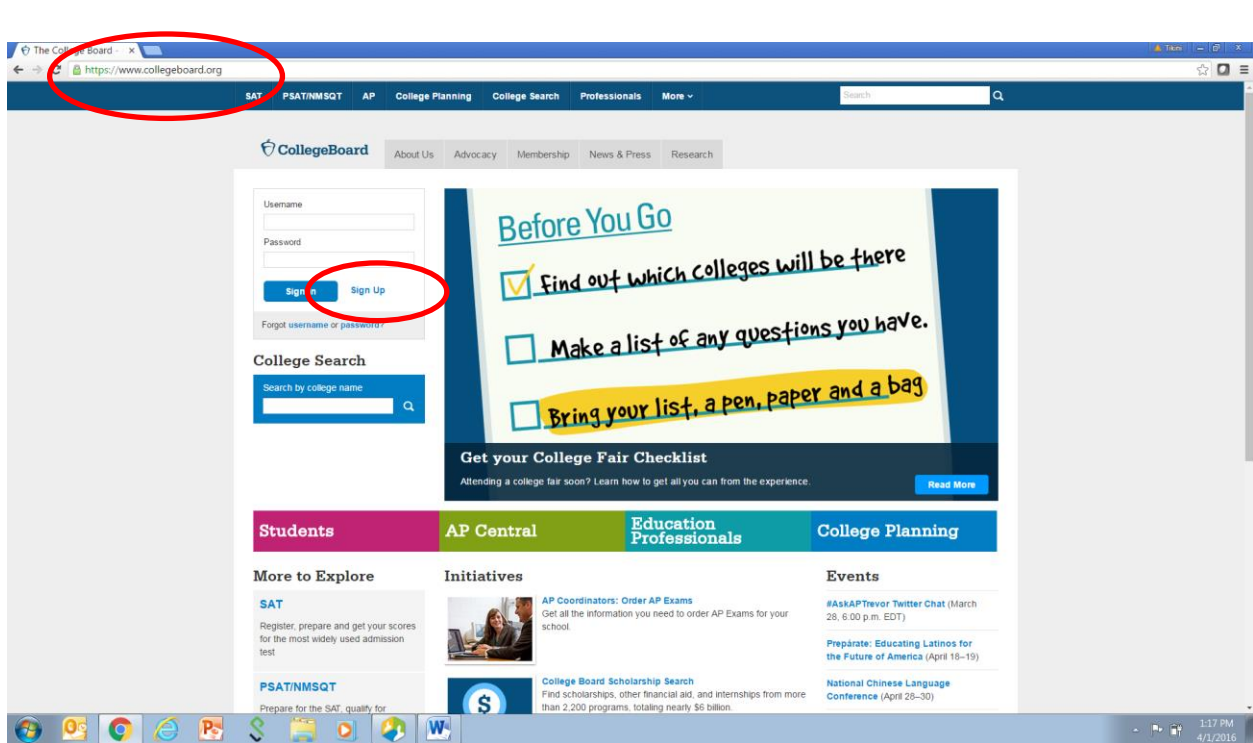
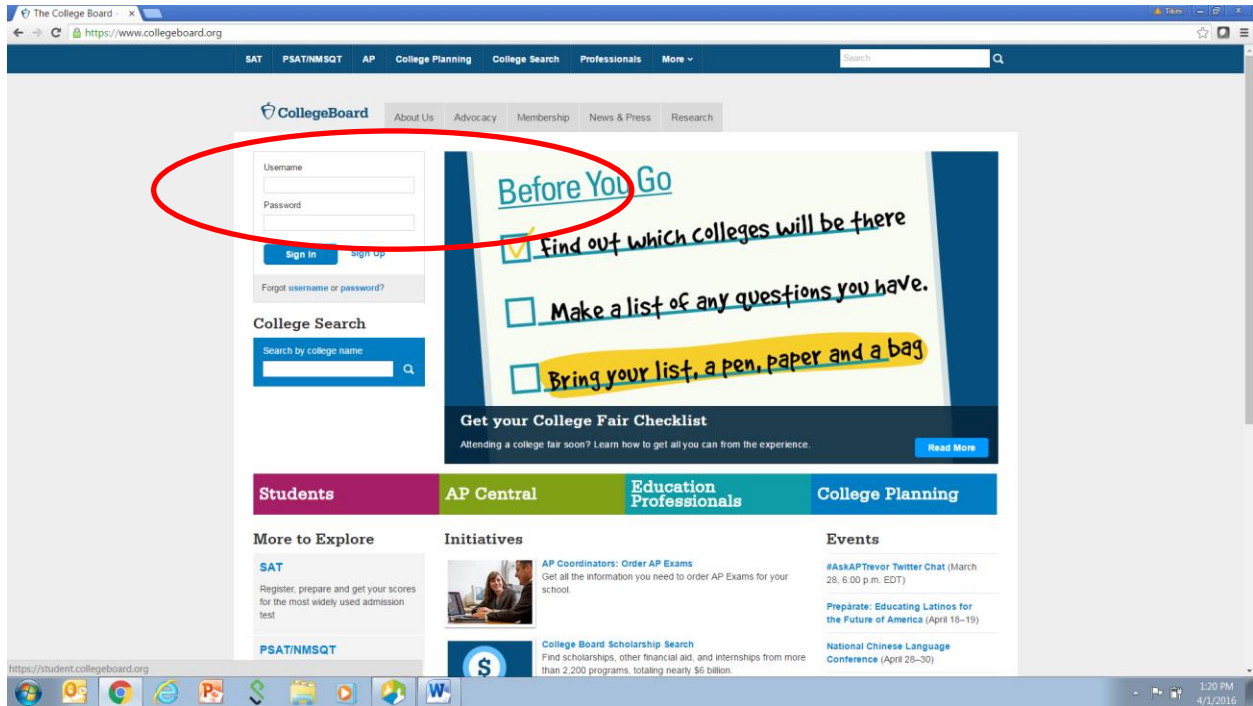


If the student does not have a College Board account, they must create an account by visiting: collegeboard.org (see screen shot below) and select Sign up



If the student has a College Board account have them sign in by visiting:
collegeboard.org and then insert their username and password



Students will select PSAT/NMSQT and/or Get my PSAT/NMSQT scores

After viewing results (see below), they select SAT Practice on Khan Academy (see box below on right) and then follow linking directions as they appear on the screen.
