Advanced Placement Test Performance

2021-2022 Data



Winter Springs High School administered 1038 Advanced Placement exams in 26 courses (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are English Language and Composition, US History, World History, English Literature and Composition, and US Government and Politics.

WSHS had an average **pass rate of 65%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

SAT Scores

All juniors and seniors at WSHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Winter Springs High School SAT score is **992** out of 1600, higher than the Florida average of 983.

WSHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

WSHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **925** out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 890.

College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness

61% of WSHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

WSHS also offers **3 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Certified Food Safety Manager and Certified Food Protection Manager (ServSafe®). In total, students earned **136 industry certifications**.
